Acquire Situational Awareness

Observed & Communicated.

Use a checklist—write stuff down!

Hazard Assessment

Fire Behavior / Building Construction—ROOF!

Command Climate / Structural Watch Outs.

Hazard Mitigation

Re-think Strategy & Tactics?

LCES / Briefings / Use all crewmembers as resources.

Limit the time you are exposed to the Hazard.

Decision Point – What is the worse thing that can happen?

Consciously weigh options. Barriers to decision making?

What can go wrong? What will go wrong?

Evaluation

Are conditions changing? / Are S & T working?

Are negative human factors working against you?

5-Step Briefing Format

Current situation

Current and developing life safety issues.

Overall strategy and tactics.

The assignment

Assignment is described along with the intent.

Specific task or tasks to complete the assignment.

Hazards associated with the assignment are identified.

How to make the assignment safe

Recognition of the hazards by all crewmembers.

Ways to mitigate the hazards. LCES!

How to support the assignment

Safety & logistical support.

What tools do you need to accomplish the tactic/task.

Questions / concerns?

Question: Does everyone know what were doing & why?

Concerns: Are we risking ourselves too much?
